## **TOURNAMENT RULES:**

1. This is a non-sanctioned event open to all adult bowlers,
2. **RESERVED ENTRIES PAID IN FULL ARE DUE AT THE ASSOCIATION OFFICE BY SATURDAY, MARCH 10, 2018.**
3. Walk-ins will be allowed if lanes are available.
4. Bowlers will compete in one (1) of the two (2) divisions: **Open or Women.** Women may choose to bowl in the open or women's division. All male bowlers must bowl in the open division.
5. Handicap for all bowlers will be based on 90% of 220. Handicap will be calculated after the completion of the three (3) games of no-tap (9=X). **Please note: any bowler with a total no-tap (9=X) score of 659 or higher will receive zero (0) pins handicap based on the 90% of 220 rule.**
6. All bowlers are asked to check in no later than five (5) minutes before the start of practice. Failure to appear prior to the start of the tournament may result in forfeiture of your entry fee.
7. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice prior to scoring.
8. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games of No-Tap (9=X) across six (6) lanes moving right after each game. **There will be no match play following the three (3) games of no-tap (9=X).**
9. Total no-tap (9=X) score with handicap will determine final standings in each division.
10. Cash prizes will be based on the number of entries. Minimum 1 in 8 to cash. All prize monies returned 100%.
11. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in resolving any disputes or dealing with any unforeseen situations or emergencies.
