TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. This tournament is open to all adult Tonawandas USBC members, male and female.
2. Non-association members may enter by purchasing a USBC membership (\$21) or by paying an affiliate fee (\$7).
3. **RESERVED ENTRIES PAID IN FULL ARE DUE AT THE ASSOCIATION OFFICE BY SATURDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2018.**
4. Walk-ins will be allowed if lanes are available.
5. All bowlers with a 210 and lower average are eligible to participate in this event and will compete in one division (See rule #8).
6. Handicap for all bowlers will be 100% of 210.
7. All USBC rules will be in effect. USBC rules 319c-e are waived for this competition.
8. Entrants will use their highest 2017-2018 average (summer sessions included), minimum 21 games.
9. Entrants without a 2017-2018 average must use their highest current USBC average as of November 25, 2018, minimum 21 games.
10. All bowlers are responsible for verifying their average. Failure to report the correct average to the Tournament Director prior to the end of the first game in the qualifying round will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of bowler's entry fee and an alternate will be given the position vacated.
11. **All bowlers are asked to check in 30 minutes prior to bowling.** Failure to appear prior to the start of the tournament will result in forfeiture of your entry fee.
12. Lane assignments and pairings will be determined by the tournament directors. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice prior to scoring for the qualifying round.
13. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games skipping one (1) pair to the right after each game.
14. One (1) rerack per game is allowed. Additional reracks **must** be authorized by a tournament official. Unauthorized reracks will result in the bowler receiving zero for the frame in which the unauthorized rerack took place.
15. Based on total pin fall with handicap, 1 out of 6 entrants from the qualifying round will advance to the first round of the finals.
16. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position, a complete 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be bowled on a pair designated by the Tournament Director. Scores bowled in roll-offs will include handicap, with each bowler receiving 1/5 of their single game handicap rounded off to the lowest whole number. The roll-off will be repeated until the tie is broken. No practice will be allowed during the roll-off. The bowler with the highest game from the qualifying round will determine the starting lane and who will begin the roll-off.
17. All matches during the finals will consist of a one (1) game eliminator format by pair to determine the Champion. Bowlers will draw for lane assignments each round. All matches are Eliminator Style and you only bowl against the bowlers on your pair. Total pin fall with handicap will determine which bowlers advance to the next round. Final two (2) bowlers will bowl for the title. Two (2) practice balls will be allowed on each lane for the first round only! No practice balls will be allowed in subsequent rounds.
18. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position during match play, a complete 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be bowled on the same pair of lanes. Scores bowled in roll-offs will include handicap, with each bowler receiving 1/5 of their single game handicap rounded off to the lowest whole number. The roll-off will be repeated until the tie is broken. No practice will be allowed during the roll-off. The higher seed bowler from the initial qualifying round will determine the starting lane and who will begin the roll-off.
19. The top two (2) bowlers will receive trophies in addition to cash prizes.
20. Cash prizes will be based on the number of entries. Minimum 1 in 6 to cash. All prize monies returned 100%.
21. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in resolving any disputes or dealing with any unforeseen situations or emergencies, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule #329.
