TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. All USBC members are eligible to enter.
2. Non-USBC members may enter by purchasing an Association membership: Adults: \$21, Youth: \$10 or, by paying a participation fee: Adults: \$5 Youth: \$2
3. Adult bowler must be 21 years of age or older.
4. All USBC rules will be observed. **USBC Rules 319(a, d, and e) are waived for this competition.**
5. Paid entries, \$25 per team, must be submitted by Noon, Saturday, November 17, 2018
6. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. **ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.**
7. Each team shall be made up of one adult and one youth bowler.
8. Bowlers will compete in one of two divisions:
 - A – combined team average of 351 and over
 - B – combined team average of 350 and under
9. Team handicap will be: **90% of 450 (total Handicap over 450 will result in negative handicap)**
10. All bowlers are responsible for the accuracy of their average. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to completion of the first game of the first series shall disqualify the bowler.
11. Youth bowlers will use highest book average from 2017-2018 (includes summer 2018 leagues) min. of 12 games.
12. Adult bowlers will use highest book average from 2017-2018. Min. of 21 games.
13. Bowlers without a sanctioned average will bowl scratch and have their average/handicap determined at the completion of bowling.
14. **Bowlers may not use non-USBC sanctioned averages.**
15. Multiple participation is allowed, but the same team cannot bowl more than once.
16. Participation of one adult with multiple youths may be allowed at the discretion of the tournament director. Entry fee will also be determined by director.
17. Substitutes will be allowed. No changes in line-up except for substitutes will be allowed. No vacancy scores allowed.
18. Bowlers are asked to report **30 minutes before** starting time.
19. Foul detecting devices will be in operation.
20. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in resolving all disputes or dealing with any unforeseen situations or emergencies, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule #329.

Awards: This is a trophy tournament. No Scholarships will be awarded from this tournament. Trophies to be awarded at Banquet in May (date to be determined).
