TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. All USBC Youth members are eligible to enter.
2. Non-members may enter by purchasing an Association membership (\$10)
3. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
4. Multiple entries will be allowed with different partners, first score posted will be used to calculate All-Events.
5. Paid entries, \$15 per bowler/\$30 per team **must be submitted by NOON Saturday, February 16, 2019.**
6. **ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.**
7. Teams will consist of two (2) boys, two (2) girls, or mixed.
8. Bowlers will bowl 3 games on the same pair.
9. Bowlers will compete in one of the following divisions:
 - Division A** – combined bowler average of 320 and over
 - Division B** – combined bowler averages of 250 to 319
 - Division C** – combined bowler averages of 249 and under
10. Individual handicap will be 90% of 230 for both divisions.
11. Substitutes will be allowed. No changes in line-up except for substitutes will be allowed. No vacancy scores will be allowed.
12. Foul detecting devices will be in operation.
13. All bowlers are responsible for the accuracy of their average. Failure to notify a tournament official of the proper average prior to the completion of the first game shall disqualify the bowler.
14. Highest individual USBC averages as of January 5, 2019 will be used for handicap.
 - a. **If you bowl outside the Tonawanda's USBC you MUST provide proof of average from your current league. Bowlers who do not provide proof of average will bowl scratch and have their average/handicap determined at the completion of bowling.**
15. If a bowler does not have a current USBC average, bowler will use highest 2017-2018 USBC average (minimum 12 games).
16. If a bowler does not have a current year or 2017-2018 USBC average, then the bowler will bowl scratch.
17. All bowlers are asked to report **30 minutes before** starting time.
18. All USBC rules will be observed.
19. All-Events division will be based upon division assigned for the Singles competition.
20. **Bowlers MUST compete in all three (3) events (Team, Doubles, and Singles) to qualify for the All-Events competition and scholarships.** All-Events awards will be determined after the Singles competition.
21. Award fees returned 100% through scholarships and awards. ** Must be a USBC sanctioned league bowler to be eligible for Scholarships. **Scholarships to be awarded in All Events competition****
22. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in resolving all disputes or dealing with any unforeseen situations or emergencies, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule #329.
