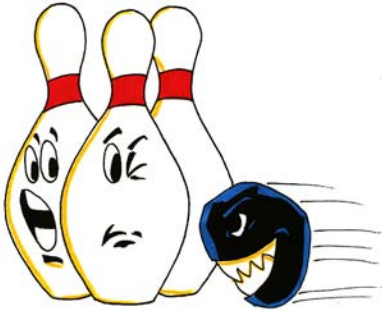

## **TOURNAMENT RULES:**

1. This tournament is open to all adult Tonawandas USBC members, male and female.
2. Non-association members may enter by purchasing a USBC membership (\$18) or by paying an affiliate fee (\$7).
3. Only one (1) entry per bowler is allowed. **RESERVED ENTRIES PAID IN FULL ARE DUE BY JANUARY 23, 2010.**
4. Bowlers submitting an entry after January 23, 2010 will pay an extra \$2 fee, which will go towards the prize fund. This includes walk-ins, if lanes are available.
5. Bowlers will compete in either of two (2) divisions:

### **Division A**

average 186 – 210

### **Division B**

average 185 or under

6. Handicap for all bowlers will be 90% of 210.
7. Entrants will use their highest 2008/2009 average, minimum 21 games.
8. Entrants without a 2008/2009 average must use their highest current USBC average as of January 9, 2010, minimum 21 games.
9. **If a bowler does not have an average to report, he/she will bowl scratch in Division A.**
10. All bowlers are responsible for verifying their average. Failure to report the correct average to the Tournament Director prior to the end of the first game in the qualifying round will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of bowler's entry fee and an alternate will be given the position vacated.
11. All USBC rules will be in effect.
12. **All bowlers are asked to check in 30 minutes prior to bowling.** Failure to appear prior to the start of the tournament will result in forfeiture of your entry fee.
13. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games across six (6) lanes, moving one (1) pair to the right after each game.
14. Total score with handicap will determine the top qualifiers for match play.
15. The total number of finalists will be determined at tournament time.
16. The top qualifiers will then bowl a step ladder match play in the finals.
17. In the event of a tie for any of the top qualifier positions or in match play there will be a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off to determine the winner. Scores bowled in roll offs will include handicap, with each bowler receiving 1/5 of their single game handicap rounded off to the lowest whole number. The roll off will be repeated until the tie is broken.
18. In case of a tie for any other position the bowler with the highest single game score with handicap in the qualifying round will be awarded the higher position in the step ladder finals.
19. All finals match bowlers will be allowed two (2) practice balls on each lane before bowling for score.
20. Each finals match will be one (1) game, single elimination. Total pins with handicap will decide the winner of each match, with the winner advancing to the next round. See Tournament Rule 17 in the event of a tie.
21. Non-appearance regardless of the cause during match play will constitute forfeiture of the match, with the bowler present bowling unopposed.
22. The top two (2) bowlers from each division will receive trophies in addition to cash prizes.
23. Cash prizes will be based on the number of entries. Minimum 1 in 8 to cash. All prize monies returned 100%.
24. **The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in resolving any disputes or dealing with any unforeseen situations or emergencies, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule #329.**
