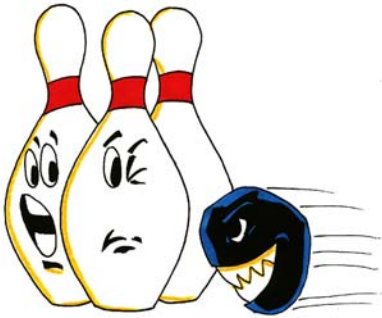

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is open to Tonawandas USBC members, male and female, age 50 and older.
2. All bowlers must be at least 50 years of age by tournament date.
3. Non-association members may enter by purchasing a USBC membership (\$18) or by paying an affiliate fee (\$7).
4. One (1) entry per bowler. **RESERVED ENTRIES ARE DUE BY DECEMBER 12, 2009.**
5. Bowlers submitting an entry after December 12, 2009 will pay an extra \$2 fee, which will go towards the prize fund. This includes walk-ins, if lanes are available.
6. Handicap for all bowlers will be 90% of 230.
7. Entrants will use their highest 2008/2009 average, minimum 21 games.
8. Entrants without a 2008/2009 average must use their highest current USBC average as of December 6, 2009, minimum 21 games.
9. If a bowler does not have an average to report, he/she will bowl scratch.
10. All bowlers are responsible for verifying their average.
11. All USBC rules will be in effect.
12. **All bowlers are asked to check in 30 minutes prior to bowling.** Failure to appear prior to the start of the tournament will result in forfeiture of your entry fee.
13. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games across six (6) lanes. Total score with handicap will determine the top five (5) qualifiers.
14. The top five (5) qualifiers will then bowl a step ladder match play in the finals. In the event of a tie for any of the top five qualifier positions or in match play there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll off to determine the winner. Scores bowled in roll offs will include handicap.
15. Trophies will be awarded to **1st and 2nd place tournament finishers** as well as **cash prize to top scratch score from the qualifying round.**
16. Cash prizes will be based on the number of entries. Minimum 1 in 8 to cash. All prize monies returned 100%.
17. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in resolving any disputes or dealing with any unforeseen situations or emergencies.
