As an entrant in the Annual State Queen's Tournament, I understand and agree to the following:

- To abide by all rules and regulations of the USBC and all such special rules as are published by the New York State USBC Queens Tournament
- After March 19<sup>th</sup>, I cannot transfer or sell my entry except with the consent of the Tournament Chair. If unable to appear, I will notify the tournament chair who may, at her option, permit or authorize a transfer of my entry. In no case is the NYS USBC Queen's Tournament obligated to refund the entry fee unless a replacement is secured
- Only replacements appearing at the Queens Tournament bowling center will be put on a waiting list to replace an absent or tardy bowler who has not notified the tournament chair. All replacement bowlers must fill out a new form and pay the fee to bowl. Original bowler will be placed on waiting list if there is another squad
- Bowlers must be registered 30 minutes prior to the squad time
- The tournament chair may arrange for telecasts or broadcasts of the tournament without cost to me and without sharing revenue derived from them with me.
- I authorize the NYS USBC WBA, Inc. and its assignees, and any news media or radio station, having permission from or acting for the benefit of NYSUSBCWBA, Inc. to show and reproduce my name and any photograph(s) taken of me by any of the above.
- In regard to suitable attire for the Queen's Tournament, may we suggest that skirts or dress slacks be worn. If questionable, the tournament committee will decide.

# GENERAL RULES -- REGULATIONS -- INFORMATION

*Certified by the United States Bowling Congress*

Strike'N Spare Lanes has Synthetic Lane Beds and Wood Approaches

Entrants must be current members in good standing of the USBC, New York State USBC Women's Bowling Association, Inc. and a local association in order to participate in the NYS USBC WBA, Inc. Queens Tournament, or have a current affiliate membership card.

Each participant may enter only once.

**NO RESERVATIONS:** All paid entries will be accepted on a first come basis until closing date, unless schedule is filled sooner. This is a scratch tournament. All pins are dropped at the start of each round.

**AVERAGE:** An entrant must hold a current USBC sanctioned league average of 160 or higher, for 21 games or more in New York State during the 2008-2009 season or 21 games or more in the current season. Note: If an entrant wishes to participate in Div. I even though their average qualifies for Div. II, they have that choice. Averages for Div. II must be verified as of March 19, 2010 by Association Manager or President. (FORM PROVIDED w/confirmation). In Div. II, if current average is 10 pins over the previous year's average and qualifies for Division I, bowler will be placed in Division I. Entrants in Div. 3 must enter either the Senior Div. of age 50 and over OR the Average Div. they qualify for. Rule 319c is waived. Rule 319a regarding reporting incorrect averages shall apply.

All bowlers shall report 30 minutes prior to scheduled time. There will be no more than five bowlers on a pair.

**1ST ROUND:** The first round will consist of four (4) games bowled on four separate pairs of lanes. Pins dropped after this round.

**2ND ROUND:** Qualifiers will be bowlers rolling the highest scores in first round. At least one out of every 6 entries will qualify for the semi-final round and bowl three more games. Additional qualifiers will be at the discretion of the Queens Tournament Committee. Qualifiers will come from all squads of the first round and based on the number of entries in each squad.

**FINAL ROUND:** IN THE STEPLADDER FINALS, the top five (5) qualifiers from each division will bowl one game elimination matches. In the first match, the fifth qualifier will bowl the fourth qualifier. The winner of this match and each match to follow will advance to the next game, and finally meet the leading qualifier in the championship match.

**TIES:**

**1st Round:** In the event of a tie for last place in either division, a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off will be held to determine the last qualifying position or positions. The loser(s) of the roll-off will receive a cash prize.

**2nd Round and Final Rounds:** In the event of a tie for any of the first five (5) positions in either division, a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off will be bowled until the tie is broken to determine the position and/or winner.

**DISQUALIFICATION:**

A participant may be disqualified immediately and removed from the tournament for any of the following:

- An infraction of the rules.
- Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the tournament.
- Use of foreign substances which come in contact with the approaches of the lanes and/or use of abrasives on surface of bowling ball during competition.
- Use of any equipment not approved by USBC Equipment Specifications Committee.

**DISQUALIFICATION OF AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THE ENTRY FEE AND ANY RIGHT TO PRIZE MONEY AND/OR AWARDS.**

New York State smoking laws will prevail.

The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.

Participants are requested to wear suitable attire for the Queen's Tournament. May we suggest that skirts or dress slacks be worn. (NO "SHORT" SKIRTS OR "SHORT" SHORTS).
