While many people came to visit, spend a little time and get in on the raffles the tournament portion of our event consisted of a non-sanctioned No Tap (9 pins = Strike) tournament where bowlers bowled 3 games with handicap for total pinfall. 47 bowlers came out to compete in two divisions. In the Open division it would be Daniel Griggs taking the top spot as he shot a no tap 300 game along with a 277 to bowl 797 scratch! Marc Cutting (two 266 games), Jon Gerrtiz (280), Ron Krzystek(266, 268) followed next all bowling a 779. Next up Warren Bush (275) with 777 followed by Evan Bush (268) with 776 and Dave Gottler (264) with 776, Dan Eberl (290) and Tom Bilson (278) finished with 775 to round out the top 9 bowlers who cashed for the event.

Other scores of note in the Open division included Tiffany Mitchell (234, 235, 241), Tricia Zemla (230, 244, 246), Nick DiPota (300), James Austin (253), Scott Clinton (253), Michael Kwiatowski (241), Kevin Kemp (241), John Rowell (287), Joe Schamdel (255, 243), Jeff Krywcum (256), Justin Schmadel (233), Nick Dudkowski (240), Jaharra DiPota (240, 244), Paul Krull (two 234s), Eric Shine (242), Bob Skovenski (262), Meech Jackson (224, 223), Trevor Palamuso (230) and Jim Bilson (227).

It would be Jazz Igiel with games of 218 and 224 and Tina Hutchins who won the women's event in 2019, rolling games of 212 and 244.
